Expanded Function Dental Assistants Final Order


Dear Mr. Nyce:

The Independent Regulatory Review Commission has suggested revisions to sections of the final form regulation #16A-465 (relating to certification of expanded function dental assistants) that were submitted for your review on February 29, 2000, and at the Commission's request, we are requesting that the time for review of the regulations be tolled to revise Section 33.103 (relating to examinations), Section 33.105 (relating to biennial renewal of licenses and certificates), Section 33.114 (relating to first certification examinations), and Section 33.205a (relating to practice as an expanded function dental assistant).

Revisions reflect editorial changes to these sections. Specifically, the words "for licensure" in Section 33.103, should have been deleted to be consistent with the certification language. These two words are now deleted. The reference to "their licenses" in Section 33.105, is also deleted so that the regulation is consistent with references to certificates only for expanded function dental assistants. In addition, the Board is replacing the strike-out for the initial five subsections (a) to (e), which was inadvertently omitted in the final form regulation. Finally, the additional and superfluous period in Section 33.205a, is removed.
