I would like to urge the IRRC to take the strongest possible actions to investigate and oversee the oil and gas industry. For the past two years, I have been documenting incidents of environmental degradation caused by natural gas drilling in Pennsylvania, and it is clear that the current regulations are inadequate. I endorse the measures proposed by the Environmental Quality Board (<http://www.pabulletin.com/secure/data/vol40/40-28/1248.html>) and the regulations suggested by Harvey Consultantants (http://www.earthjustice.org/sites/default/files/library/legal_docs/padep-recommendations.pdf).
