PACD's Public Comments on the 105 Regulatory Proposal for Fee Revisions:

The Pennsylvania Association of Conservation Districts (PACD) - representing all 66 conservation districts - believes that the conservation districts that are delegated the Chapter 105 program should directly collect the General Permit fee in reference to the 105 Regulatory Proposal of Fee Revisions. We further believe that, once that opportunity is established by the specific language provided below, a discussion should take place on the details of the distribution of the General Permit fee in an updated 105 delegation agreement.

Therefore, we suggest that proposed §105.13(a) be amended as follows: "by a check payable to — Commonwealth of Pennsylvania" then insert "or to a Delegated County Conservation District."
