Environmental Quality Board  
Control of Volatile Organic Compound  
Emissions from Automobile and Light-Duty  
Truck Assembly Coating Operations and  
Heavier Vehicle Coating Operations

On July 13, 2015, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this proposed regulation from the Environmental Quality Board (EQB). This rulemaking amends 25 Pa. Code Chapter 129. The proposed regulation was published in the August 8, 2015 *Pennsylvania Bulletin* with a 67-day public comment period. The final-form regulation was submitted to the Commission on July 15, 2016.


This regulation adds reasonably available control technology (RACT) requirements and RACT emission limitations for the control of volatile organic compound emissions from automobile and light-duty truck assembly coating operations and heavier vehicle coating operations, as well as related cleaning activities.

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the EQB (35 P.S. § 4005(a)(1) and (8)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
