After reading thru the proposed changes I'm a bit concerned on the modification inspection report submittal. Currently it is 60 days for the Inspection Modification Report and the new proposed time frame is 30 days. The problem is that the various trades complete their task at different time frames. For instance ACVL could be done long before TL. Or AFMX will complete their task long before TL. These time frames could well exceed 45 days. So unless you want an inspection modification for each trade, the 30 days will not be enough time.
