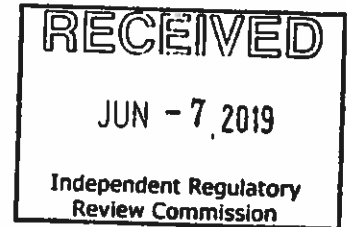

My name is Thalia Gray and I am writing in support of the PA DEP's proposed Title V permit fee schedule changes. I strongly support improved air quality for my region and I believe that the money being generated by the existing fee schedule is not enough to fund the program. Revenue shortfall has resulted in reduced Air Quality Program staffing, which impedes the department's ability to effectively and quickly issue plan approvals and operating permits.
