RE: proposed regulations to Pennsylvania's Charter School Law:

Dear Department of Education:

I heartily support the proposed changes to Pennsylvania's Charter School Law that are being promulgated by the Wolf Administration.

The education of every child is a public concern, and nothing is more essential to the "pursuit of happiness".

Charter schools must meet the uniform, common standards established by the Department of Education, but too often they have become the domain of private interests and have been granted exceptions to the highest, uniform standards. All schools, including charter schools, must be held to the same standards of equity, transparency, ethics, performance, curriculum, and accountability.

Like all schools, public and private, charter schools may supplement the uniform, secular standards, but they should not be granted exemptions or exceptions to "best practices".

Our elected officials must safeguard all children and assure that all students receive quality education. These regulations are good news for Pennsylvania and its school children.
